

Please bring the following information with you to your enrollment interview:

1. Identification: your driver's license and social security card, or birth certificate.
2. Proof of residency, such as: a rent receipt, letter from your landlord, or utility bill in your name.
3. Health insurance card or Medicaid card, if you have one.
4. Proof of all income - need four consecutive weeks of recent paycheck stubs for yourself and your spouse, if married, and any other income source.
5. Proof of age if under 21.
6. A statement from your doctor verifying pregnancy and expected date of birth.
7. Any unpaid medical bills from past 3 months. To receive assistance with those bills you must provide proof of income for those months.

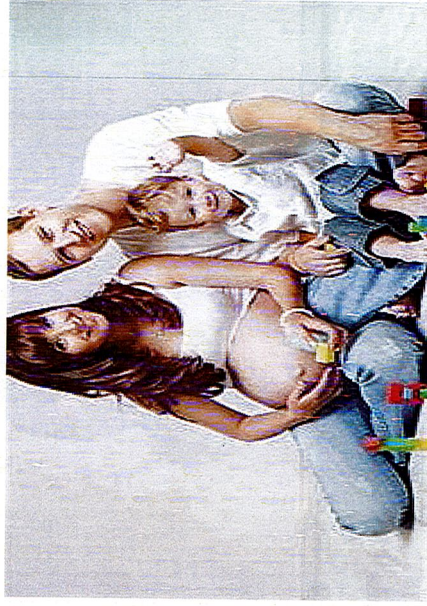

WHAT IS NOYES FIRST STEPS?



Noyes First Steps is a Health Support Service Program at Noyes Memorial Hospital that supports insurance enrollment, education, and the complex social needs of pregnant women.

If you are eligible after the enrollment interview, expanded Medicaid will pay for hospital inpatient care and medical care for up to 60 days after the birth month.

You could be eligible for medical coverage the day you apply.

Noyes First Steps serves pregnant women of all ages, who need additional support during and after pregnancy.

Services begin as early as possible, preferably the first trimester.

Our goal is to see each client 4-5 times throughout their pregnancy and provide the social, emotional, and educational support to promote a healthy pregnancy.

Why are these services important?

- ▼ To help identify and work towards overcoming obstacles that may prevent a healthy pregnancy.
- ▼ To maximize a child's healthy start in life.

Services are available to pregnant women of any age, regardless of insurance.

- ▼ Prenatal health education: nutrition, labor and delivery.
- ▼ Confidential HIV counseling.
- ▼ Free Classes: Childbirth and Infant Feeding.
- ▼ Referrals to other services and agencies as needed.
- ▼ Advocacy with DSS and other service providers.
- ▼ Assistance and information on housing, transportation, breast pumps, car seats and other needs.
- ▼ Individual and family concerns.
- ▼ Assistance with paternity and custody issues.
